Jamie- Financial Update

I sent the report out before the meetings.

\$75,000.00 Check book account. Bottle drop \$125.00 and Papa Murphy brought in more money. \$10.00 from Campbell soups. Room party funds request was turned in. Only \$800.00 to \$900.00. Teachers are starting to spend money.

Moore field trips planned. 3rd grade going to the hop game. The problem is with the bus. They can pay for a event, and if the bus cancels day of field trip (which they can) then they lose the money. OMSI is coming for Kindergarten and 1st grade. OMSI coming is \$500.00 so they have excess money.

5th grade fundraising is at \$1,200.00. See's candy and movie concession.

Request for OBOB to purchase a set of OBOB books per class instead of per grade. Ask the library what the appropriate number of copies for OBOB.

Library got about \$2,000.00 dollars from the book fair.

Dance: Outdoor exterior entrance – pop corn, glow in the dark paint – Glow with Kindness – loose St. Patrick Day theme – photo op – and the cafeteria will be open for a quieter space. DJ "Bach to Rock"

Volunteer openings for the dance is slim. Social media volunteer dance ask. David will be there. Custodial has been arranged. Popcorn being popped early. Do we need someone specific to help? Check with David about volunteer times and getting pop corn ready.

Carnival:
